





Global warming is the long-term rise in the average temperature of Earth's atmosphere and oceans since the mid-20th century. Scientists believe global warming is caused by increasing concentrations of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere, which trap heat from the sun.

Tornado

What is a tornado?

A tornado is a rotating column of air that is in contact with both the surface of the Earth and a cumulonimbus cloud or, in some cases, a cumulus cloud. It is often, but not always, associated with a severe thunderstorm, particularly a supercell.

How do you survive a tornado?

If you are indoors, stay away from windows, doors, and outside walls. If you are outdoors, lie flat on the ground. If you are in a vehicle, exit and lie flat on the ground.
